## Vocabulary Boosters

A large vocabulary can turn your child into a better reader and writer. Try these everyday ways to help your student learn new words.

**Keep your ears open.** When you and your youngster go places, point out words that people use. Maybe a waiter describes an *entrée* or the dentist talks about *molars*. Encourage your child to figure out what they mean by the way they are used.

**Go beyond nouns.** Help your youngster add verbs and adjectives to their vocabulary. Sports and games offer opportunities to use action words. Let your child hear you comment on the basketball that *soars* or the runner who *sprints*. When they send thank-you notes or greeting cards, suggest descriptive words (a *polka-dot* shirt, a *fantastic* birthday).
